Biography

Mr. Bronstein represents individuals and businesses in connection with tax audits and appeals before the Internal Revenue Service at the administrative level as well as litigation in the United States Tax Court and other federal courts relating to tax matters, including Bankruptcy Court, with respect to state and local tax matters. Mr. Bronstein also represents and consults business entities of all sizes relating to the selection of the appropriate business entity, its formation, operation, sale or reorganization, and disposition and dissolution of such entities with an emphasis on tax planning.

Mr. Bronstein prepares and administers wills and trusts, including charitable trusts and foundations; obtains appointments for representatives in the probate courts for will administration and takes the representative through the entire administrative process; handles appointments of conservators and guardians for minors and incompetents; preparation of premarital agreements; prepares business documents that effectively relate to business owners' estate and financial planning, including member, partner, and shareholder redemption, cross-purchases, and deferred compensation agreements; and litigates estate and trust-related matters.
